



Basic instructions for using Country Paint Defender

Defender is a great, simple way to put a hard durable finish on your project. It has multiple uses and applications, and can be used in place of waxing.

Always stir, do not shake during use. Apply with a brush or a Country Paint lambswool applicator for a nice smooth finish. Always try to maintain a wet edge while applying.

If you are top coating a stained project, please allow one hour between coats. Three coats are recommended for maximum durability. Lightly sand between coats with our Silky Smooth Sanding Pad. Wipe away any dust with a damp cloth and allow to dry between coats.

If you are top coating a painted surface, typically only one coat will be required. If you are top coating a painted surface such as a table top, or highly used surface, please follow the instructions above for applying multiple coats.

You may also add your Defender directly to your Chalked Country Paint, to create a wax free, chalky, one step finish! We like to mix 1/3 defender to 2/3 paint.
