



Basic instructions for using Country Paint Refinish Gel Rub

Refinish Gel Rub is a heavy-bodied stain that does not penetrate as deeply into wood. Unlike traditional liquid stains, this provides a deep, rich, even color, and is much easier to use. There is no sanding between coats, and can be easily layered to achieve different looks and shades. Refinish Gel Rub is great for those hard to stain surfaces. It also covers nicely on already painted surfaces.

Always sand your surface lightly before applying the gel rub. You can use a Country Paint lambswool applicator, brush, or rag, whichever you prefer.

Always apply in the direction of the wood grain. You may also wipe off any excess stain if you prefer depending on the finish you are going for.

If you wish to distress, please allow 24 hours drying time. You can also apply a second coat for those stubborn areas.

Always allow 48 hours drying time before applying top coat.

Finish off with our Top Coat Defender for maximum protection.

Remember to always properly dispose of your rags, as this product is combustible.
